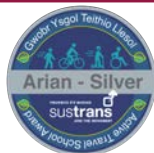

To mark International Languages day in Year 1 and 2 we have learned Spanish colours in Expressive Arts.



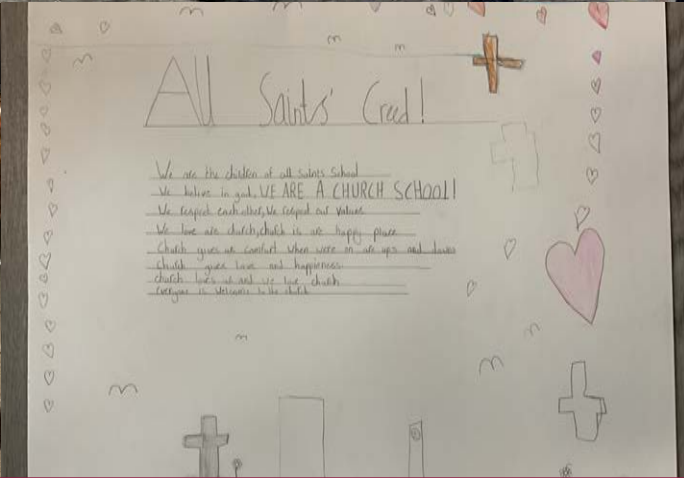
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Blyddyn 3 & 4 - Deva Experience

Pupils in Year 5 and 6 have also been busy using manipulatives to support their calculations in Mathematics and Numeracy this week.



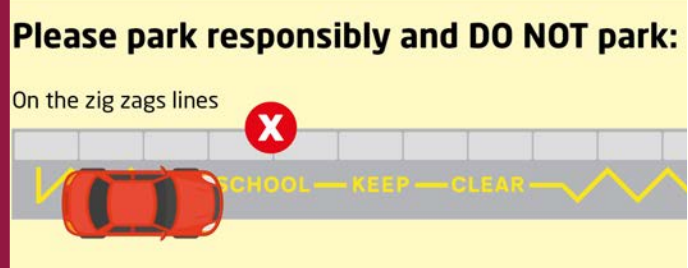
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Derbyn - Phonics, Patterns and Continuous Provision

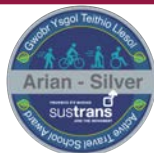

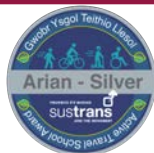

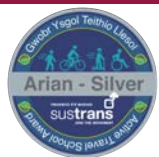
